The exchange programme of the ACC, the IT-folkehøjskolen Snoghøj, the Rite Tautas Augstskola (Latvia) and the Friendships Association of Fredericia and Siauliai (Denmark and Lithuania) has gained support from the Demokratifonden (Danish ministry of foreign affairs). The amount granted to the main operator, the IT-folkehøjskolen, is approximately 22.500 €

The project is referred to as "Change here for the networking society" ("Netværkssamfundet -alle skifter").

Five students from Siauliai (Lithuania) and two students from Aknieste (Latvia) will take part in the autumn course at the IT-folkehøjskolen Snoghøj. The exchange programme should be seen as a first step in realizing the projects/headlines "Rite wired" and "CrossBaltic IT-workshops".
